In its 51st year, the Ann Arbor Art Fair is still going strong. One of Michigan's biggest arts fairs, the event encompasses four different festivals; The Ann Arbor Street Art Fair, The State Street Art Fair, The Ann Arbor Summer Art Fair, and Ann Arbor's South University Art Fair.

The fair kicks off Wednesday, July 21 and runs through Saturday, July 24. The hours are 10 a.m.-9 p.m. Wednesday through Friday and 10 a.m.-6p.m. on Saturday.
